

2 Corinthians 12:9-10_{HCSB}

⁹ But He said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for (MY) power is perfected in weakness." Mark 9:14-16_{kJV}

And when he came to his disciples, he saw a great multitude about them, and the scribes questioning with them.

¹⁵ And straightway all the people, when they beheld him, were greatly amazed, and running to him saluted him.

¹⁶ And he asked the scribes, What question ye with them?





Mark 9:17-18_{KJV}

And one of the multitude answered and said, Master, I have brought unto thee my son, which hath a dumb spirit;

¹⁸ And wheresoever he taketh him, he teareth (break, throw down) him: and he foameth, and gnasheth with his teeth, and pineth away (waste away): and I spake to thy disciples that they should cast him out; <u>and</u> they could not.





Matthew 17:14-16_{KJV}

And when they were come to the multitude, there came to him a certain man, kneeling down to him, and saying,

¹⁵ Lord, have mercy on my son: for he is lunatick, (moonstruck, epilepsy) and sore vexed (suffering): for ofttimes he falleth into the fire, and oft into the water.

¹⁶ And I brought him to thy disciples, <u>and they could</u> not cure him.





Luke 9:38-40_{kJV}

- And, behold, a man of the company cried out, saying, Master, I beseech thee, look upon my son: for he is mine only child.
- ³⁹ And, lo, a spirit taketh him, and he suddenly crieth out; and it teareth (convulsions) him that he foameth again, and bruising him hardly departeth from him.
- ⁴⁰ And I besought thy disciples to cast him out; <u>and</u> they could not.





Mark 9:19-21_{kJV}

He answereth him, and saith, O faithless (unbelief, no trust) generation, how long shall I be with you? how long shall I suffer (to hold up) you? **bring him unto me**.

²⁰ And they brought him unto him: and when he saw him, straightway the spirit tare (convulsions) him; and he fell on the ground, and wallowed (rolled) foaming.

²¹ And he asked his father, How long is it ago since this came unto him? And he said, Of a child.



Mark 9:22-24_{kJV}

- And ofttimes it hath cast him into the fire, and into the waters, to destroy him: but if thou canst do any thing, have compassion on us, and help us.
- ²³ Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth (trusts).
- ²⁴ And straightway the father of the child cried out, and said with tears, Lord, I believe; help thou mine unbelief.





Mark 9:25-27_{KJV}

When Jesus saw that the people came running together, he rebuked the foul spirit, saying unto him, Thou dumb and deaf spirit, I charge thee, come out of him, and enter no more into him.

²⁶ And the spirit cried, and rent (convulsion) him sore, (much) and came out of him: and he was as one dead; insomuch that many said, He is dead.

²⁷ **But Jesus** took him by the hand, and lifted him up; and he arose.



Mark 9:28-29_{kJV}

And when he was come into the house, his disciples asked him privately, Why could not we cast him out?

²⁹ And he said unto them, This kind can come forth by nothing, but by prayer and fasting.
