Hebrews 11:1-2_{kJV}

¹Now **faith** (*Trust*, persuasion) is the **substance** (a setting or placing under, substructure, foundation; assurance, confidence) **of things hoped for** (*Tikvah*, *rope* - expectation of good, *PT*), the **evidence** (proof) of things not seen.

² For by it the elders obtained a good report.

⁶But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God <u>must believe that he is</u>, and that <u>he is a rewarder of them</u> that **diligently** seek him. [zeal, enthusiasm]

Luke 7:3-7_{HCSB}

³ When the centurion heard about Jesus, he sent some Jewish elders to Him, requesting Him to come and save the life of his slave. 4 When they reached Jesus, they pleaded with Him earnestly, saying, "He is worthy for You to grant this, 5 because he loves our nation and has built us a synagogue." ⁶ Jesus went with them, and when He was not far from the house, the centurion sent friends to tell Him, "Lord, don't trouble Yourself, since I am not worthy to have You come under my roof. ⁷ That is why I didn't even consider myself worthy to come to You.



Matthew 8:8-9_{HCSB}

8 ... "I am not worthy to have You come under my roof. But only say the word, and my servant will be cured.

⁹ For I too am a man under authority, having soldiers under my command. I say to this one, 'Go!' and he goes; and to another, 'Come!' and he comes; and to my slave, 'Do this!' and he does it."





Matthew 8:10-12_{HCSB}

¹⁰ Hearing this, Jesus was amazed (to wonder, admire, marvel) and said to those following Him, "I assure you: I have not found anyone in Israel with so great a faith!

¹¹ I tell you that many will come from east and west, and recline at the table with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob in the kingdom of heaven.

¹² But the sons of the kingdom will be thrown into the outer darkness. In that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth."
