# Isaiah 49:13-16<sub>KJV</sub>

<sup>13</sup> Sing (screech), O heavens; and be joyful (turn around), O earth; and break forth into singing, O mountains: for the Lord hath **comforted** (sigh, be sorry, pity, Per.) his people, and will have **mercy** (fondle, compassion, love deeply) upon his **afflicted** (depressed, in mind or circumstances). <sup>14</sup> But Zion said, The Lord hath **forsaken** (to leave, loosen, abandon, relinquish, Per.) me, and my Lord hath **forgotten me** (to mislay, oblivious, Per.). <sup>15</sup> Can a woman **forget** (Imp.) her sucking child, that she should not have compassion on the son of her womb? yea, they may **forget** (Imp.), yet will I not **forget** (Imp.) thee.



# Isaiah 49:13-16<sub>KJV</sub>

<sup>16</sup> Behold, I have **graven** (to cut, hack, law decree, Per.) thee upon the **palms of my hands** (or sole); thy walls are **continually** (stretched) before me.



# John 20:24-29 HCSB

<sup>24</sup> But one of the Twelve, Thomas (called “Twin”), was not with them when Jesus came. <sup>25</sup> So the other disciples kept telling him, “We have seen the Lord!” But he said to them, “If I don’t see the mark of the nails in His hands, put my finger into the mark of the nails, and put my hand into His side, I will never believe!” <sup>26</sup> After eight days His disciples were indoors again, and Thomas was with them. Even though the doors were locked, Jesus came and stood among them. He said, “Peace to you!” <sup>27</sup> Then He said to Thomas, “Put your finger here and observe My hands. Reach out your hand and put it into My side. Don’t be an unbeliever, but a believer.” <sup>28</sup> Thomas responded to Him, “My Lord and my God!” <sup>29</sup> Jesus said, “Because you have seen Me, you have believed. Those who believe without seeing are **blessed (Happy).**”
