- ² And he saw also a certain poor widow casting in thither two mites.
- ³ And he said, Of a truth I say unto you, that this poor widow hath cast in more than they all:
- ⁴ For all these have of their abundance cast in unto the offerings of God: but she of her penury hath cast in all the living that she had.



Luke 21:5-7_{KJV}

- ⁵ And as some spake of the temple, how it was adorned with goodly stones and gifts, he said,
- ⁶ As for these things which ye behold, the days will come, in the which there shall not be left one stone upon another, that shall not be thrown down.
- ⁷ And they asked him, saying, Master, but when shall these things be? and what sign will there be when these things shall come to pass?





Zechariah 8:18-19_{kJV}

¹⁸ And the word of the Lord of hosts came unto me, saying,

¹⁹ Thus saith the Lord of hosts; The fast of the fourth month, and the fast of the fifth, and the fast of the seventh, and the fast of the tenth, shall be to the house of Judah joy and gladness, and cheerful feasts; therefore **love the truth and peace**.





Zechariah 7:2-4_{HCSB}

² Now the people of Bethel had sent Sharezer, Regemmelech, and their men to plead for the Lord's favor

³ by asking the priests who were at the house of the Lord of Hosts as well as the prophets, "Should we mourn and fast in the fifth month as we have done these many years?"

⁴ Then the word of the Lord of Hosts came to me:





Zechariah 7:5-7_{HCSB}

⁵ "Ask all the people of the land and the priests: When you fasted and lamented in the fifth and in the seventh months for these 70 years, did you really fast for Me?

⁶ When you eat and drink, don't you eat and drink simply for yourselves?

⁷ Aren't these the words that the Lord proclaimed through the earlier prophets when Jerusalem was inhabited and secure, along with its surrounding cities, and when the southern region and the Judean foothills were inhabited?"



Zechariah 7:8-10_{HCSB}

- ⁸ The word of the Lord came to Zechariah:
- ⁹ "The Lord of Hosts says this: Make fair (Truth) decisions. Show faithful love (Grace) and compassion (womb) to one another.
- ¹⁰ Do not oppress the widow or the fatherless (James 1:27), the foreigner or the poor, and do not plot evil in your hearts against one another.





Zechariah 6:11-10_{HCSB}

¹¹ Take silver and gold, make crowns and place them on the head of **Joshua** son of Jehozadak, the high priest.

¹² You are to tell him: This is what the Lord of Hosts says: **Here is a man whose name is Branch**; He will branch out from His place and build the Lord's temple.

13 Yes, He will build the Lord's temple; He will be clothed in splendor and will sit on His throne and rule. There will also be a priest on His throne, and there will be peaceful counsel between the two of them.



Psalm 85:6-8_{HCSB}

⁶ Will You not revive us again so that Your people may rejoice in You?

⁷ Show us Your faithful love (grace), Lord, and give us Your salvation.

⁸ I will listen to what God will say; surely the Lord will declare peace to His people, His godly ones, and not let them go back to foolish ways.
