# Colossians 2:2-3<sub>KJV</sub>

<sup>2</sup> That their hearts might be comforted, being knit together in love, and unto all riches of the full assurance of understanding, to the acknowledgement of the mystery of God, and of the Father, and of Christ;

<sup>3</sup> In whom are hid all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.



# Colossians 2:2-3<sub>KJV</sub>

<sup>2</sup> That their hearts might be **comforted** (call near, encouraged, strengthened), **being knit together** (drive together, united, *pass.*) in **love** (*agape*), and **unto** (*for*) all riches of the **full assurance** (entirely or completely confident) of **understanding** (mentally put together), to the **acknowledgement** (*da'as- knowledge*) of the **mystery** (*raz*) of God, and of the Father, and of Christ;

<sup>3</sup> In whom are hid all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.



# 1 John 4:16-18<sub>KJV</sub>

<sup>16</sup> And we have known and believed the love that God hath to us. God is love; and he that dwelleth in love dwelleth in God, and God in him.

<sup>17</sup> Herein is our love made perfect, that we may have boldness in the day of judgment: because as he is, so are we in this world.

<sup>18</sup> There is no fear in love; but perfect love **casteth** (throw or let go of a thing without caring where it falls, give over to one's care uncertain about the result) out fear: because fear hath torment\*. He that feareth is not made perfect in love.

# 1 John 4:19-21<sub>KJV</sub>

<sup>19</sup> We love him, because he first loved us.

<sup>20</sup> If a man say, I love God, and hateth his brother, he is a liar: for he that loveth not his brother whom he hath seen, how can he love God whom he hath not seen?

<sup>21</sup> And this commandment have we from him, That he who loveth God love his brother also.
