Matthew 9:35-38_{KJV}

³⁵ And Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people. ³⁶ But when he saw the multitudes, he was moved with compassion on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd. ³⁷ Then saith he unto his disciples, The harvest truly is plenteous, but the labourers are few; ³⁸ **Pray** (to want, to desire, beg) ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he will send forth labourers into his harvest.



Ephesians 6:18-20_{KJV}

18 Praying (to offer prayers) always with all **prayer** (prayers addressed to God or the place of prayer; worship) and **supplication** (a prayer, a petition, a need) in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all **perseverance** (persistency) and supplication for all saints;

19 And for me, that utterance may be given unto me, that I may open my mouth boldly, to make known the mystery of the gospel,

20 For which **I am an ambassador** (to be older, representative) in bonds: that therein **I may speak boldly** (to be frank, freedom of speech), as I ought to speak.



Colossians 4:2-4_{KJV}

² Continue in prayer, and watch in the same with thanksgiving;

³ Withal praying also for us, that God would open unto us a door of utterance (*logos, something said, word*), to speak the mystery of Christ, for which I am also in bonds:

⁴ That I may make it manifest, as I ought to speak.

Philippians 1:3-6_{KJV}

³ I thank my God upon every remembrance of you,

⁴ Always in every **prayer** (petition) of mine for you all making **request** with **joy** (cheerfulness, calm delight),

⁵ For your fellowship in the gospel from the first day until now;

⁶ **Being confident** (persuaded) of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you **will perform** (to fulfill further or completely, execute, bring to an end, accomplish, perfect) it until the day of Jesus Christ:
