

## Matthew 9:35-38<sub>kJV</sub>

<sup>35</sup> And Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people. <sup>36</sup> But when he saw the multitudes, he was moved with compassion on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd. <sup>37</sup> Then saith he unto his disciples, The harvest truly is plenteous, but the labourers are few; <sup>38</sup> Pray (to want, to desire, beg) ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he will send forth labourers into his harvest.

## Ephesians 6:18-20<sub>kJv</sub>

<sup>18</sup> Praying (to offer prayers) always with all prayer (prayers addressed to God or the place of prayer; worship) and supplication (a prayer, a petition, a need) in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance (persistency) and supplication for all saints;

<sup>19</sup> And for me, that utterance may be given unto me, that I may open my mouth boldly, to make known the mystery of the gospel,

<sup>20</sup> For which I am an ambassador (to be older, representative) in bonds: that therein I may speak boldly (to be frank, freedom of speech), as I ought to speak.



## Colossians 4:2-4<sub>kJV</sub>

- <sup>2</sup>Continue in prayer, and watch in the same with thanksgiving;
- <sup>3</sup> Withal praying also <u>for us</u>, that God would open unto <u>us a door</u> **of utterance** (*logos*, something said, word), to speak the mystery of Christ, for which I am also in bonds:
- <sup>4</sup> That I may make it manifest, as I ought to speak.
