

#### Colossians 1:1-3<sub>kJV</sub>

- <sup>1</sup> Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ **by** the will of God, and Timotheus our brother,
- <sup>2</sup> To the saints and faithful brethren in Christ which are at Colosse: Grace be unto you, and peace, from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.
- <sup>3</sup> We give thanks to God and the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, praying always for you,



# Colossians 1:4-6<sub>kJV</sub>

- <sup>4</sup> Since we heard of your faith in Christ Jesus, and of the love which ye have to all the saints,
- <sup>5</sup> For the hope which is laid up for you in heaven, whereof ye heard before in the word of the truth of the gospel;

<sup>6</sup> Which is come unto you, as it is in all the world; and **bringeth forth fruit**, **as it doth also in you**, since the day ye heard of it, and **knew the grace of God in truth**:



# Colossians 1:4-6<sub>kJV</sub>

- <sup>4</sup> Since we heard of your faith (Trust) in Christ Jesus, and of the love (Agape) which ye have to all the saints,
- <sup>5</sup> For the hope (expectation of good) which is laid up (reserved) for you in heaven, whereof ye heard before in the word of the truth of the gospel;

<sup>5</sup> Both spring from the confident hope that you will receive what is stored up for you in heaven. You heard of this hope earlier in the message about the truth. This Good News



# Romans 2:4<sub>kJV</sub>

<sup>4</sup> Or despises (take for granted) thou the riches (wealth) of his goodness (generosity) and forbearance (Grace) and longsuffering (slow of anger and patience); not knowing that the goodness (Grace) of God leadeth thee to repentance?

# Exodus 34:6<sub>HCSB</sub>

<sup>6</sup> ... Yahweh-Yahweh is a compassionate and gracious
God, slow to anger and rich in faithful
love (Grace) and truth,



# Colossians 1:21-23<sub>KJV</sub>

- <sup>21</sup> And you, that were sometime alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now hath he reconciled
- <sup>22</sup> In the body of his flesh through death, to present you holy and unblameable and unreproveable in his sight:
- <sup>23</sup> If ye continue in the faith (Trust) grounded and settled, and be not moved away from the hope of the gospel, which ye have heard,...
