

Galatians 4:8-9_{kJV}

⁸ Howbeit then, when ye **knew not God**, ye did service unto them which by nature are no gods. ⁹ But now, after that ye have known God, or rather are known of God, how turn ye again to the weak and beggarly elements, whereunto ye desire again to be in bondage?

OJB: 8 But, formerly, when you did not have da'as (knowledge, to perceive)* of Hashem, you were avadim (slaves) serving that which is by nature not HaEl Ha'Amiti (the true G-d).

Hosea 4:6_{kJV}

⁶ My people are destroyed for lack of **knowledge**: because thou hast rejected **knowledge**, I will also reject thee, that thou shalt be no priest to me: seeing thou hast forgotten the law of thy God, I will also forget thy children.

Hosea 6:6-7_{kJV}

⁶ For I desired mercy (*chesed*: grace), and not sacrifice; and the **knowledge** of God more than burnt offerings. ⁷ But they like men (Adam) have transgressed the covenant: there have they dealt treacherously against me.

Galatians 4:7_{kJV}

⁷ Wherefore thou art no more a **servant** (slave), but a son; and if a son, then an **heir** (a sharer by lot, i.e. inheritor) of God through Christ.

Galatians 4:1-6_{kJV}

¹ Now I say, That the heir, as long as he is a child, differeth nothing from a servant, though he be lord of all; ² But is under tutors and governors until the time appointed of the father. ³ Even so we, when we were children, were in bondage under the elements of the world: 4 But when the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law, ⁵ To **redeem** (payment of a price to recover from the power of another) them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons. ⁶ And because ye are sons, God hath sent forth the Spirit of his Son into your hearts, crying (raven), Abba, Father.
