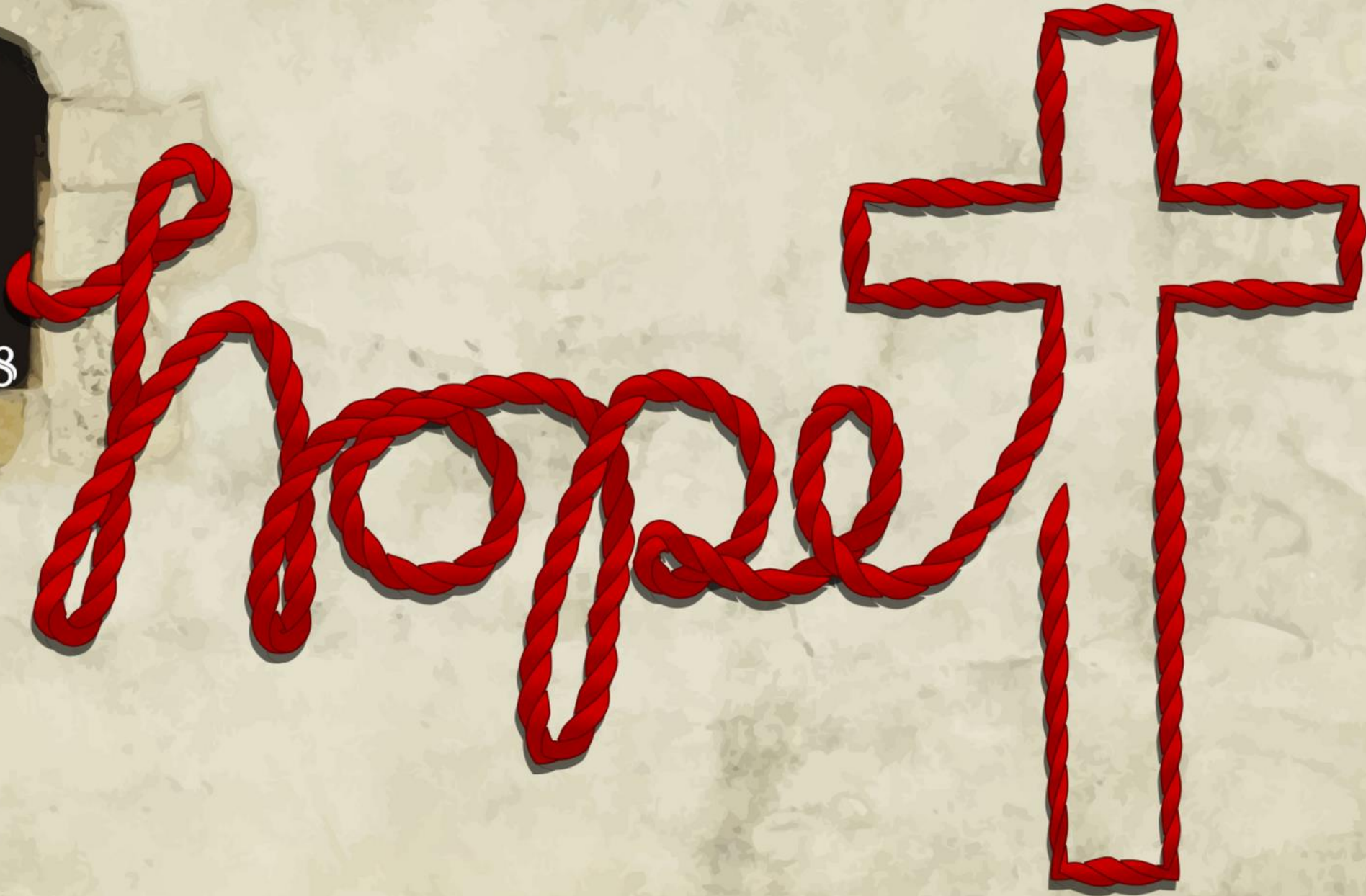

Hebrews 2:11-13^{HCSB}

¹¹ For the One who sanctifies and those who are sanctified all have one Father. That is why Jesus is not ashamed to call them brothers,

¹² saying: I will proclaim Your name to My brothers; I will sing hymns to You in the congregation.

¹³ Again, I will trust in Him. And again, Here I am with the children God gave Me.



Hebrews 2:14-16_{HCSB}

¹⁴ Now since the children have flesh and blood in common, Jesus also shared in these, so that through His death He might destroy the one holding the power of death—that is, the Devil—

¹⁵ and free those who were held in slavery all their lives by the fear of death.

¹⁶ For it is clear that He does not reach out to help angels, but to help Abraham's offspring.



Hebrews 2:17-18_{HCSB}

¹⁷ Therefore, He had to be like His brothers in every way, so that He could become a merciful and faithful high priest in service to God, to make propitiation for the sins of the people.

¹⁸ For since He Himself was tested and has suffered, He is able to help those who are tested.



Go'el

Participle of the Hebrew word gal'al (deliver, redeem, rescue)

“Redeemer”: technical term applied to a person who as the nearest relative of another is placed under certain obligations to him.

Kinsman Redeemer



Kinsman Redeemer: duties (Leviticus 25, Numbers 5)

- (1) Redeem a relative who had sold himself into slavery to a foreigner because of poverty.
- (2) Redeem property that had been sold because of poverty.
- (3) Marry the childless widow, to keep property and family name.
- (4) Receive restitution if relative had died.
- (5) The law of blood-revenge. Was a sacred duty of the nearest relative to avenge the blood of his kinsman. He was called the go'el-ha-dam, "the avenger of blood."



Kinsman Redeemer: qualifications

- (1) Must be a relative kinsman.
- (2) Must be free yourself.
- (3) Must be able to pay the price.
- (4) Must be willing to pay the price.



Genesis 48:16_{KJV}

¹⁶ The Angel which **redeemed** me from all evil,
bless the lads; and let my name be named on them,
and the name of my fathers Abraham and Isaac;
and let them grow into a multitude in the midst of
the earth.



Exodus 6:6_{KJV}

⁶ Wherefore say unto the children of Israel, I am the Lord, and I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, and I will rid you out of their bondage, and I will **redeem** you with a stretched out arm, and with great judgments:

Exodus 15:13_{KJV}

¹³ Thou in thy mercy (**grace**) hast led forth the people which thou hast **redeemed**: thou hast guided them in thy strength unto thy holy habitation.



Psalm 107:2_{KJV}

² Let the **redeemed** of the LORD say so, whom he hath **redeemed** from the hand of the enemy;

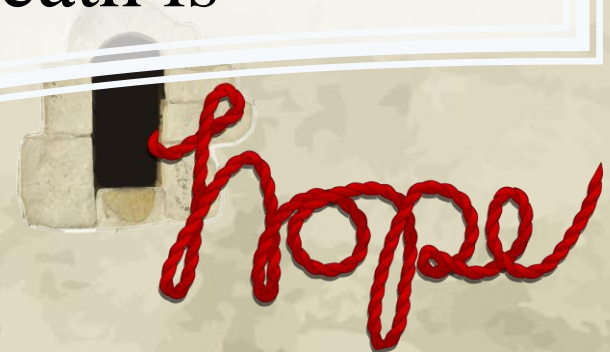
Hosea 13:14_{KJV}

¹⁴ I will **ransom** them from the power of the grave; I will **redeem** them from death: O death, I will be thy plagues (**where is your punishment**); O grave, I will be thy destruction (**where is your sting**): repentance shall be hid from mine eyes.



1 Corinthians 15:52-54_{KJV}

⁵² In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed. ⁵³ For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality. ⁵⁴ So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory.



1 Corinthians 15:55-KJV

⁵⁵ O death, where is thy sting? O grave, where is thy victory? ⁵⁶ The sting of death is sin; and the strength of sin is the law. ⁵⁷ But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. ⁵⁸ Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye stedfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord.



Philippians 3:20-21_{HCSB}

²⁰ but our citizenship is in heaven, from which we also eagerly wait for a **Savior** (Messiah- Go'el), the Lord Jesus Christ. ²¹ He will transform the body of our humble condition into the likeness of His glorious body, by the power that enables Him to subject everything to Himself.



Romans 11:25-27 HCSB

²⁵ For I would not, brethren, that ye should be ignorant of this mystery, lest ye should be wise in your own conceits; that blindness in part is happened to Israel, until the fulness of the Gentiles be come in.

²⁶ And so all Israel shall be saved: as it is written, There shall come out of Sion the **Deliverer** (Go'el), and shall turn away ungodliness from Jacob: ²⁷ For this is my covenant unto them, when I shall take away their sins!



John 8:34_{ESV}

³⁴ Jesus answered them, “Truly, truly, I say to you, everyone who practices sin is a slave to sin.

Romans 6:18_{ESV}

¹⁸ and, having been set free from sin, have become slaves of righteousness.

John 8:36_{ESV}

³⁶ So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed.
