Lamentations 3:22-24_{KJV}

²² It is of the Lord's **mercies** (chesed: Grace) **that we are not consumed** (to be complete, be finished, be at an end. Perfect Tense), **because his compassions** (womb, tender love) **fail not** (to be at an end, to cease, to accomplish. Perfect Tense).

²³ They are new every morning: **great** (much, many, abounding) is thy faithfulness.

²⁴ The Lord is my **portion** (inheritance -of land), **saith** (to speak. Perfect Tense) my soul; **therefore will I hope** (to wait, be patient, expect) in him.



Matthew 12:1-2_{KJV}

¹ At that time Jesus went on the sabbath day through the corn; and his disciples were an hungred, and began to pluck the ears of corn and to eat.

² But when the Pharisees saw it, they said unto him, Behold, thy disciples do that which is not lawful to do upon the sabbath day.



Matthew 12:3-5_{KJV}

³ But he said unto them, Have ye not read what David did, when he was an hungred, and they that were with him;

⁴ How he entered into the house of God, and did eat the shewbread, which was not lawful for him to eat, neither for them which were with him, but only for the priests?

⁵ Or have ye not read in the law, how that on the sabbath days the priests in the temple profane the sabbath, and are **blameless** (guiltless, innocent)?



Matthew 12:6-8_{KJV}

⁶ But I say unto you, That in this place is one **greater than** (larger-
especially in age, elder, stronger) the temple.

⁷ But if ye had known what this meaneth,

“I will have mercy, and not sacrifice,”

ye would not **have condemned** (judged, pronounced guilty) the
guiltless (guiltless, innocent).

⁸ For the Son of man is Lord even of the sabbath day.
