

Mysteries Revealed



Ephesians 5:22-33_{KJV}

²² Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, as unto the Lord. ²³ For the husband is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church: and he is the saviour of the body. ²⁴

Therefore as the church is subject unto Christ, so let the wives be to their own husbands in every thing. ²⁵ Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it; ²⁶ That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word, ²⁷ That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.



Ephesians 5:22-33_{KJV}

²⁸ So ought men to love their wives as their own bodies. He that loveth his wife loveth himself. ²⁹ For no man ever yet hated his own flesh; but nourisheth and cherisheth it, even as the Lord the church: ³⁰ For we are members of his body, of his flesh, and of his bones. ³¹ For this cause shall a man leave his father and mother, and shall be joined unto his wife, and they two shall be one flesh. ³² **This is a great mystery: but I speak concerning Christ and the church.** ³³ Nevertheless let every one of you in particular so love his wife even as himself; and the wife see that she reverence her husband.



Ephesians 5:22-33_{KJV}

²² Wives, **submit** (to subordinate, to arrange under) yourselves unto your own husbands, as unto the Lord. ²³ For the husband is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church: and he is the **savior** (deliverer-Go'el) of the body. ²⁴ Therefore as the church is subject unto Christ, so let the wives be to their own husbands in every thing. ²⁵ Husbands, **love** (agape) your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it; ²⁶ That he might **sanctify** (to make holy) and **cleans**e (purge, purify) it with the washing of water by the **word** (rhema-spoken), ²⁷ That he might present it to himself a **glorious** (held in great esteem) church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without **blemish** (without blame).



Ephesians 5:22-33_{KJV}

²⁸ So ought men [JESUS] to love their wives [the church – YOU] as their own bodies. He that loveth his wife loveth himself. ²⁹ For no man ever yet hated his own flesh; but **nourisheth** (rear up to maturity: feed, sustain, maintain) and **cherisheth** (keep warm: lovingly protect and care) it, even as the Lord the church: ³⁰ For we are **members** (limb) of his body, of his flesh, and of his bones. ³¹ For this cause shall a man leave his father and mother, and shall be joined unto his wife, and they two shall be one flesh^{*}. ³² **This is a great mystery: but I speak concerning Christ and the church.** ³³ Nevertheless let every one of you in particular so love his wife even as himself; and the wife see that she reverence her husband.



John 17:21-23_{KJV}

²¹ That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me.

²² And the glory which thou gavest me I have given them; that they may be one, even as we are one:

²³ I in them, and thou in me, **that they may be made perfect in one;** and that the world may know that thou hast sent me, and hast loved them, as thou hast loved me.
