# 1 Timothy 3:14-16<sub>KJV</sub>

<sup>14</sup> These things write I unto thee, hoping to come unto thee shortly:

<sup>15</sup> But if I tarry long, that thou mayest know how thou oughtest to behave thyself in the house of God, which is the church of the living God, the pillar and ground of the truth.

<sup>16</sup> And without controversy great is the **mystery of godliness**: God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory.



## 2 Peter 1:1-3<sub>KJV</sub>

<sup>1</sup> Simon Peter, a servant and an apostle of Jesus Christ, to them that have obtained like precious faith with us through the righteousness of God and our Saviour Jesus Christ:

<sup>2</sup> Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God, and of Jesus our Lord,

<sup>3</sup> According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and **godliness**, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue:



# 1 Timothy 4:6-9<sup>KJV</sup>

<sup>6</sup> If thou put the brethren in remembrance of these things, thou shalt be a good minister of Jesus Christ, nourished up in the words of faith and of good doctrine, whereunto thou hast attained.

<sup>7</sup> But refuse profane and old wives' fables, and exercise thyself rather unto **godliness**.

<sup>8</sup> For bodily exercise profiteth little: but **godliness** is profitable unto all things, having promise of the life that now is, and of that which is to come.

<sup>9</sup> This is a faithful saying and worthy of all acceptance.
