

John 12:12-16_{KJV}

¹² On the next day much people that were come to the feast, when they heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem, ¹³ Took branches of palm trees, and went forth to meet him, and cried, Hosanna: Blessed is the King of Israel that cometh in the name of the Lord. 14 And Jesus, when he had found a young donkey, sat thereon; as it is written, ¹⁵ Fear not, daughter of Sion: behold, thy King cometh, sitting on an donkey's colt.* 16 These things understood not his disciples at the first: but when Jesus was glorified, then remembered they that these things were written of him, and that they had done these things unto him.

Zechariah 9:9_{KJV}

⁹ **Rejoice** (spin around) **greatly** (vehemently), O daughter of Zion; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem: behold, thy King cometh unto thee: he is **just** (lawful, righteous), **and having salvation** (*yaw-shah*', to be open, wide or free, to be safe, to be saved); lowly, and riding upon an *donkey*, and upon a colt the foal of an *donkey*.

Psalm 118:25-26_{kJV}

²⁵ Save now (yaw-shah', to be open, wide or free, to be safe, to be saved), I beseech (awn-naw', oh now!)* thee, O Lord: O Lord (Yeh-ho-vaw': Jehovah, the self-existent one), I beseech thee, send now prosperity (to push forward, break out, to go over or through as a river, to succeed or be successful)*. ²⁶ Blessed be he that cometh in the name of the Lord: we have blessed you out of the house of the Lord.

*Yaw-shah + awn-naw = Hosanna
The feminine noun (Yeshua) means salvation



Genesis 24:12-16_{kJV}

¹² And he said O Lord God of my master Abraham, I pray thee, send me good speed this day, and shew kindness (chesed, grace) unto my master Abraham. ¹³ Behold, I stand here by the well of water; and the daughters of the men of the city come out to draw water: ¹⁴ And let it come to pass, that the damsel to whom I shall say, Let down thy pitcher, I pray thee, that I may drink; and she shall say, Drink, and I will give thy camels drink also: let the same be she that thou hast appointed for thy servant Isaac; and thereby shall I know that thou hast shewed kindness unto my master.

- ²¹ And the man wondering at her held his peace, to wit whether the LORD had made his journey prosperous or not.
- ⁴⁰ And he said unto me, The LORD, before whom I walk, will send his angel with thee, and **prosper** thy way; and thou shalt take a wife for my son of my kindred, and of my father's house:
- ⁴² And I came this day unto the well, and said, O LORD God of my master Abraham, if now thou do **prosper** my way which I go:
- ⁵⁶ And he said unto them, Hinder me not, seeing the LORD hath **prospered** my way; send me away that I may go to my master.

Psalm 118:25-26_{kJV}

25 Save now (yaw-shah', to be open, wide or free, to be safe, to be saved), I beseech (awn-naw', oh now!)* thee, O Lord: O Lord, I beseech thee, send now prosperity (to push forward, break out, to go over or through as a river, to succeed or be successful). ²⁶ Blessed be he that cometh in the name of the Lord: we have blessed you out of the house of the Lord. ²⁷ God is the Lord, which hath shewed us light: bind the sacrifice with cords, even unto the horns of the altar. ²⁸ Thou art my God, and I will praise thee: thou art my God, I will exalt thee. ²⁹ O give thanks unto the Lord; for he is good: for his mercy (chesed, grace) endureth for ever.
