AH-MAN (primitive root): believe (44x), assurance (1x), faithful (20x), sure (11x), established (7x), trust (5x), verified (3x), steadfast (2x), continuance (2x), father (2x), bring up (4x), nurse (2x), be nursed (1x), surely be (1x), stand fast (1x), fail (1x), trusty (1x).

To prop, to stay, to sustain with the arm, to carry a child, firm, unshaken, to be faithful, trustworthy, to be sure, certain, to trust, to confide in, to believe and be faithful

to build up or support; to foster as a parent or nurse, assurance

Gen 15:6 - And he believed (AH-MAN) in the LORD; and he counted it to him for righteousness.

Do you "believe" God? Do you "believe" what he says? Do you AH MAN him?

Num 20:2: And there was no water for the congregation: and they gathered themselves together against Moses and against Aaron. And the people chode with Moses, and spake, saying, Would God that we had died when our brethren died before the LORD! And why have ye brought up the congregation of the LORD into this wilderness, that we and our cattle should die there? And wherefore have ye made us to come up out of Egypt, to bring us in unto this evil place? it is no place of seed, or of figs, or of vines, or of pomegranates; neither is there any water to drink. And Moses and Aaron went from the presence of the assembly unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, and they fell upon their faces: and the glory of the LORD appeared unto them. And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying, Take the rod, and gather thou the assembly together, thou, and Aaron thy brother, and speak ye unto the rock before their eyes; and it shall give forth his water, and thou shalt bring forth to them water out of the rock: so thou shalt give the congregation and their beasts drink. And Moses took the rod from before the LORD, as he commanded him. And Moses and Aaron gathered the congregation together before the rock, and he said unto them, Hear now, ye rebels; must we fetch you water out of this rock? And Moses lifted up his hand, and with his rod he smote the rock twice: and the water came out abundantly, and the congregation drank, and their beasts also. And the LORD spake unto Moses and Aaron, Because ye believed me not (AH_MAN ed me not!), to sanctify (to be pure-clean, set apart, holy) me in the eyes of the children of Israel, therefore ye shall not bring this congregation into the land which I have given them.

AH-MANE': firm, faithful,...verily, truly, so be it! Its proper place is where one person confirms the words of another and expresses a wish for the issue of his vows or predictions. SO BE IT!

1st 13 times it was used to confirm the curse for breaking the law! (mainly in DEU. 27) Then mainly confirming the blessedness of the Lord.

Jer 28:5 Then the prophet Jeremiah said unto the prophet Hananiah in the presence of the priests, and in the presence of all the people that stood in the house of the LORD, Even the prophet Jeremiah said, (AH_MAINE) Amen: the LORD do so: the LORD perform thy words which thou hast prophesied, to bring again the vessels of the LORD'S house, and all that is carried away captive, from Babylon into this place.

Very next chapter in **Jeremiah 29:11**: For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.

Do you desire God to do? Do you desire to say, "Please GOD, so be it!"? Will you say AH MAINE to God today?

Even in the New Testament this word continues. Known as the best-known word in all the world it was Transliterated exactly into the Greek as: AH_MAINE

Greek: translates it 51x as AH-MAINE, and 101x as **VERILY! Every time Jesus says, "Verily-verily I say unto you"**: firm, faithful, used at the beginning of a discourse it will means- surely, truly, of a truth...used at the end of a discourse it means- so it is, so be it, may it be fulfilled!

This was a custom which passed over from the Jewish synagogues to the Christian churches, that when something was read or said...the listener responded with AH-MAINE to make what was said their own!
