# Matthew 8:5-7<sub>KJV</sub>

<sup>5</sup> And when Jesus was entered into Capernaum, there came unto him a centurion, beseeching him,

<sup>6</sup> And saying, Lord, my servant lieth at home sick of the palsy, grievously tormented.

<sup>7</sup> And Jesus saith unto him, I will come and heal him.



# Matthew 8:8-10<sub>KJV</sub>

<sup>8</sup> The centurion answered and said, Lord, I am not worthy that thou shouldst come under my roof: but speak the word only, and my servant shall be healed. <sup>9</sup> For I am a man under authority, having soldiers under me: and I say to this man, Go, and he goeth; and to another, Come, and he cometh; and to my servant, Do this, and he doeth it. <sup>10</sup> When Jesus heard it, he marvelled, and said to them that followed, Verily I say unto you, I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel.



# Matthew 8:11-13<sub>KJV</sub>

<sup>11</sup> And I say unto you, That many shall come from the east and west, and shall sit down with Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, in the kingdom of heaven.

<sup>12</sup> But the children of the kingdom shall be cast out into outer darkness: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

<sup>13</sup> And Jesus said unto the centurion, Go thy way; and as thou hast believed, so be it done unto thee. And his servant was healed in the selfsame hour.



# Matthew 8:5-7<sub>KJV</sub>

<sup>5</sup> And when Jesus was entered into Capernaum, there came unto him a centurion, **beseeching** (to call to or for, call near, *comfort*, "make a call" from being "close-up and personal.") him,

<sup>6</sup> And saying, Lord, my servant lieth at home sick of the palsy, grievously tormented.

<sup>7</sup> And Jesus saith unto him, I will come **and heal** (to wait upon, serve, relieve of disease, *therapeutic root*) him.



# Matthew 8:8-10<sub>KJV</sub>

<sup>8</sup> The centurion answered and said, Lord, I am not **worthy** (sufficient, adequate, competent, *not enough*) that thou shouldst come under my roof: but speak the word only, and my servant **shall be healed** (cure, make whole, free from errors and sins, to bring about one's salvation). <sup>9</sup> For I am a man under authority, having soldiers under me: and I say to this man, Go, and he goeth; and to another, Come, and he cometh; and to my servant, Do this, and he doeth it. <sup>10</sup> When Jesus heard it, **he marvelled** (to wonder, admire, amazed), and said to them that followed, Verily I say unto you, I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel.
