# Proverbs 2:1-6<sub>KJV</sub>

<sup>1</sup> My son, if thou wilt **receive** (take, accept) my words, and **hide** (hoard, treasure) my commandments with thee; <sup>2</sup> So that thou **incline thine ear** (pay attention) unto wisdom, and apply thine heart to **understanding** (discernment);

<sup>3</sup> Yea, if thou criest after **knowledge** (insight), and **liftest** (raise) up thy voice for understanding; <sup>4</sup> If thou **seekest** (desire) her as silver, and searchest **for her as for hid treasures** (secret storehouse, hidden riches); <sup>5</sup> Then shalt thou understand the fear of the Lord, and find the knowledge of God. <sup>6</sup> For the Lord giveth wisdom: out of his mouth cometh knowledge and understanding.



# Proverbs 2:7-9<sub>KJV</sub>

<sup>7</sup> He layeth up (hide, treasure up) sound wisdom (\*common sense) for the righteous: he is a buckler (shield) to them that walk uprightly.

<sup>8</sup> He keepeth (guards) the paths of judgment, and preserveth (keep, protect) the way of his saints.

<sup>9</sup> Then shalt thou understand righteousness, and judgment, and equity; yea, every good path.



# Proverbs 2:10-16<sub>KJV</sub>

<sup>10</sup> When wisdom entereth into thine heart, and knowledge is **pleasant** (agreeable) unto thy soul; <sup>11</sup> Discretion shall preserve thee, understanding shall keep thee: <sup>12</sup> To deliver thee from the way of the evil man, from the man that speaketh **froward** (perverse, fraud) things; <sup>13</sup> Who leave the paths of uprightness, to walk in the ways of darkness; <sup>14</sup> Who rejoice to do evil, and delight in the frowardness of the wicked; <sup>15</sup> Whose ways are crooked, and they froward in their paths: <sup>16</sup> To deliver thee from the strange woman, even from the stranger which flattereth with her words;



# John 5:37-40<sub>CSB</sub>

<sup>37</sup> The Father who sent me has himself testified about me. You have not heard his voice at any time, and you haven't seen his form. <sup>38</sup> You don't have his word residing in you, because you don't believe the one he sent. <sup>39</sup> You pore over the Scriptures because you think you have eternal life in them, and yet they testify about me. <sup>40</sup> But you are not willing to come to me so that you may have life.



## 2 Timothy 3:15-17<sup>CSB</sup>

<sup>15</sup> and you know that from infancy you have known the sacred Scriptures, which are able to give you wisdom for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus. <sup>16</sup> All Scripture is inspired by God and is profitable for teaching, for rebuking, for correcting, for training in righteousness, <sup>17</sup> so that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work.
