

Proverbs 2:1-6_{kJV}

¹My son, if thou wilt **receive** (take, accept) my words, and **hide** (hoard, treasure) my commandments with thee; ²So that thou **incline thine ear** (pay attention) unto wisdom, and apply thine heart to **understanding** (discernment);

³ Yea, if thou criest after **knowledge** (insight), and **liftest** (raise) up thy voice for understanding; ⁴ If thou **seekest** (desire) her as silver, and searchest **for her as for hid treasures** (secret storehouse, hidden riches); ⁵ Then shalt thou understand the fear of the Lord, and find the knowledge of God. ⁶ For the Lord giveth wisdom: out of his mouth cometh knowledge and understanding.

Proverbs 2:7-9_{kJV}

⁷ He layeth up (hide, treasure up) sound wisdom (*common sense) for the righteous: he is a buckler (shield) to them that walk uprightly.

⁸ He **keepeth** (guards) the paths of judgment, and **preserveth** (keep, protect) the way of his saints.

⁹ Then shalt thou understand righteousness, and judgment, and equity; yea, every good path.



Proverbs 2:10-16_{kJV}

¹⁰ When wisdom entereth into thine heart, and knowledge is pleasant (agreeable) unto thy soul; ¹¹ Discretion shall preserve thee, understanding shall keep thee: ¹² To deliver thee from the way of the evil man, from the man that speaketh **froward** (perverse, fraud) things; ¹³ Who leave the paths of uprightness, to walk in the ways of darkness; ¹⁴ Who rejoice to do evil, and delight in the frowardness of the wicked; ¹⁵ Whose ways are crooked, and they froward in their paths: ¹⁶ To deliver thee from the strange woman, even from the stranger which flattereth with her words;

³⁷ The Father who sent me has himself testified about me. You have not heard his voice at any time, and you haven't seen his form. ³⁸ You don't have his word residing in you, because you don't believe the one he sent. ³⁹ You pore over the Scriptures because you think you have eternal life in them, and yet they testify about me. ⁴⁰ But you are not willing to come to me so that you may have life.
