Kavod: properly, WEIGHT, HEAVYNESS, but only figuratively in a good sense, battle armaments that were heavy. Majesty, Splendor, Favor or Copiousness, Abundance, Wealth:—Glorious(-ly), Glory, Honour(-able). Reputation, Respect. Glory.

²⁵ Whereof I am made a minister, according to the dispensation of God which is given to me for you, to fulfil the word of God;

²⁶ Even the **mystery** (raz) which hath been hid from ages and from generations, but now is made **manifest** (make know what was hidden) to his saints:
