

## Luke 2:41-50<sub>KJV</sub>

<sup>41</sup>Now his parents went to Jerusalem every year at the feast of the passover. <sup>42</sup> And when he was twelve years old, they went up to Jerusalem after the custom of the feast. <sup>43</sup> And when they had fulfilled the days, as they returned, the child Jesus tarried behind in Jerusalem; and Joseph and his mother knew not of it. <sup>44</sup> But they, supposing him to have been in the company, went a day's journey; and they sought him among their kinsfolk and acquaintance. <sup>45</sup> And when they found him not, they turned back again to Jerusalem, seeking him.
