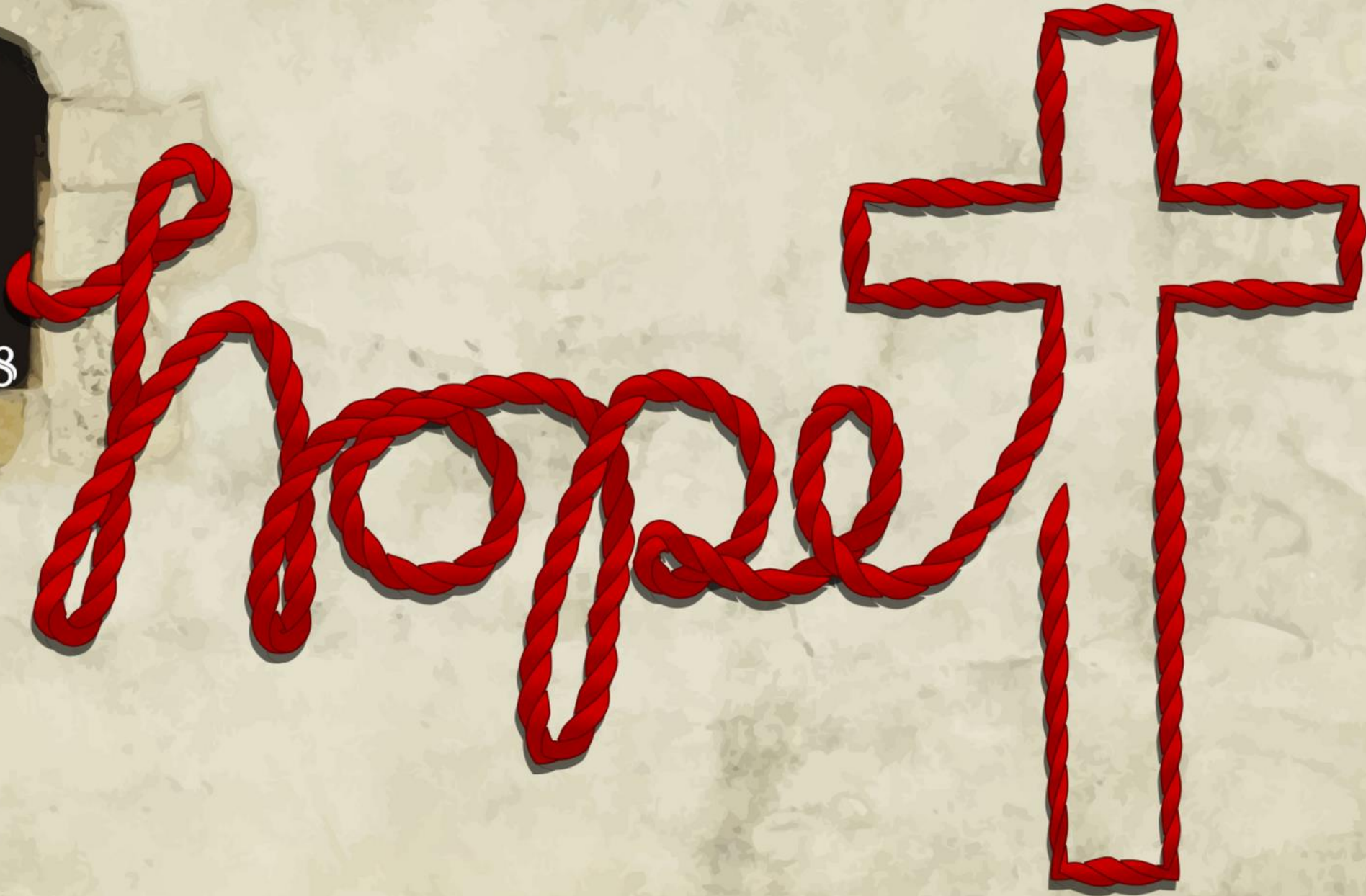

Deuteronomy 18:15-16_{HCSB}

¹⁵ “The Lord your God will raise up for you a prophet like me from among your own brothers. **You must listen to him.**

¹⁶ This is what you requested from the Lord your God at Horeb on the day of the assembly when you said, ‘Let us not continue to hear the voice of the Lord our God or see this great fire any longer, so that we will not die’



Hebrews 12:25-26_{HCSB}

25 Make sure that you do not reject the One who speaks. For if they did not escape when they rejected Him who warned them on earth, even less will we if we turn away from Him who warns us from heaven.

26 His voice shook the earth at that time, but now He has promised, Yet once more **I will shake** not only the earth but also heaven (Haggai 2:6)



Hebrews 12:27-29^{HCSB}

²⁷ This expression, “Yet once more,” indicates the removal of what can be shaken—that is, created things—so that what is not shaken (**Unshakeable**) might remain.

²⁸ Therefore, since we are receiving **a kingdom that cannot be shaken**, let us hold on to grace. By it, we may serve God acceptably, with reverence and awe (**Godly fear**),

²⁹ for our God is a consuming fire.



1 Corinthians 3:10-13 HCSB

10 According to God's grace that was given to me, I have laid a foundation as a skilled master builder, and another builds on it. But each one must be careful how he builds on it.

11 For no one can lay any other foundation than what has been laid down. **That foundation is Jesus Christ.**

12 If anyone builds on that foundation...¹³ ...the day will disclose it, because it will be revealed by fire; the fire will test the quality of each one's work.



Isaiah 28:16_{HCSB}

¹⁶ Therefore the Lord God said:

“Look, I have laid a stone in Zion, a tested stone,
a precious cornerstone, **a sure foundation**;

the one who believes will be unshakable (will not hurry).



Matthew 7:24-27 HCSB

²⁴ “Therefore, everyone who **hears these words of Mine and acts on them** will be like a sensible man who built his house on the rock. ²⁵ The rain fell, the rivers rose, and the winds blew and pounded that house. **Yet** it didn’t collapse, because its foundation was on the rock. ²⁶ But everyone who hears these words of Mine and doesn’t act on them will be like a foolish man who built his house on the sand. ²⁷ The rain fell, the rivers rose, the winds blew and pounded that house, and it collapsed. And its collapse was great!”



John 15:7_{KJV}

⁷ If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you.

John 16:24_{KJV}

²⁴ Hitherto (**Until now**) have ye asked nothing **in my name**: ask, and ye shall receive (**take**), that your joy (**cheerfulness, calm delight, gladness**) may be full (**to cram, leveled up, completely full**).

Mark 16:15-27_{KJV}

¹⁵ And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, **and preach** (to herald, proclaim, announce) the gospel to every creature.

¹⁶ He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.

-Jesus tells us to PREACH-



Romans 10:14-15_{KJV}

¹⁴ How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? and how shall they believe in him of whom they have not heard? and how shall they hear without **a preacher?**

¹⁵ And how shall they **preach**, except they be sent? as it is written, How beautiful are the feet of them that **preach the gospel of peace**, and bring glad tidings of good things!

(Isaiah 52:7)



Isaiah 52:6-7 HCSB

⁶ Therefore My people will know My name; therefore they will know on that day that I am He who says: Here I am.”

⁷ How beautiful on the mountains are the feet of **the herald**, who **proclaims** peace, who brings news of good things, who **proclaims** salvation (**Yeshuah-JESUS**) , who says to Zion, “Your God reigns!”
